

Colchester District Business Awards: Environmental Awareness Winners 2009

At a ceremony in December 2009 attended by over 600 people, Ingleton Wood won the Environmental Awareness Category of the 2009 Colchester Business of the Year Awards.

The Practice recently established an Environmental Design Discipline headed up by Robert Diamond, Ingleton Wood's in-house Sustainability Associate and Low Carbon Consultant. His passion for the environment impressed the judges, together with the work carried out by his team on low and zero carbon schemes.

Projects include the design of wind turbine and solar

hot water systems, solar photovoltaics for the generation of electricity using sunlight, ground and air source heating and cooling systems, biomass heating systems, and natural ventilation strategies to limit air conditioning loads.

Working with Ingleton Wood's building services engineers, the team is consistently researching and developing the very latest low carbon design solutions in order to provide innovative and cutting edge Environmental advice to their clients in both the Public and Private sectors.

The team can also offer

Energy Performance and Display Energy Certification for all building types, Feasibility Studies for new schemes reviewing carbon strategies, and BREEAM assessments to measure and certify the environmental performance of buildings.
